Project Name: UNIVERSAL WATER METERING PROGRAM FOR THE DISTRICT OF SPARWOOD

The Closing Date has been changed:

Meter Specifications:

- All water meters must conform to AWWA C700 standard as most recently revised
- All water meters, brass fittings and valves shall be certified by an ANSI accredited test lab per ANSI/NSF Standard 61, Drinking Water Components – Health Effects, Section 8. Proof of certification is required.

Council Resolution Regarding Volunteer Incentive:

- Council has resolved that staff prepare a bylaw with the intention of charging individual residential users \$440.00 per month for water consumption if they do not volunteer to have a water meter installed. This rate is based on maximum monthly flow through an open 5/8" or 3/4" service. Increased rates for larger services such as commercial and high density residential will also be introduced. This rate will come into effect prior to the completion date of the Universal Water Metering Program.
